## HEARING TEST RESULTS

CATEGORY I – These employees had pure-tone thresholds within normal limits in both ears. No audiological or medical recommendations are indicated.

CATEGORY II-A – These employees had hearing losses greater than 25dB in one or both ears above 2000Hz. A change from previous hearing tests has been noted. Precautions should be taken to avoid further deterioration of hearing. Whether caused by noise or some other factor, ear protection (either ear plugs or ear muffs) is required.

CATEGORY II-B – These employees had hearing losses greater than 25dB in one or both ears above 2000Hz. Repeated testing has not shown any significant changes in hearing. It is, however, strongly recommended that ear protection be worn even though it may not be required.

CATEGORY III – These employees had hearing losses in one or both ears greater than 20dB at 1000Hz. or below. This type of hearing loss may indicate a hearing loss that can be treated medically or surgically. Physician referral, further audiological testing, and/or ear protection should be considered.

CATEGORY IV - These employees had a combination of the hearing losses in Category II-A, II-B, or III in one or both ears. Recommendations include physician referral, further testing, and/or the use of ear protection.

CATEGORY V – Based on the current hearing test, these employees had a standard threshold shift in the right / left / both ears of 10 dB or greater in comparison to the baseline test.
