The Sanderson Farm Slaughterhouse will have significant *negative impacts* on our environment and our economy.

The company plans to take as much water out of wells as they can.  
Neighboring wells may dry up.

If the company receives the proposed lower water rate, the citizens of Nash County will be forced to subsidize Sanderson Farms Slaughterhouse.

500 new chicken houses will locate in Nash and neighboring counties creating *a half a billion pounds of poultry poop* each year which must be land applied.

Chickens are fed arsenic to reduce parasites which allows them to grow bigger.  
*The arsenic in chicken poop will leach into the ground and surface water over time.*

Starting pay for a production worker is \$8.00 per hour or \$ 16,640/year;  
almost \$ 1,700 below the Poverty Level for a single mother with two children.
