RELATING TO A DECISION ON  
A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS (COA)**

FILING FEE: \$200.00

Section 8.42.VI.C.6 of the City of Wilson Zoning Ordinance says that “an appeal from the commission's action in granting or denying a COA may be taken to the Board of Adjustment by any aggrieved party, within thirty (30) days of the decision, and shall be in the nature of certiorari. An appeal from the Board of Adjustment's decision shall be heard by the superior court of Wilson County.”

Appeals “in the nature of certiorari” means that the Board of Adjustment will review the case based on the record as presented to and acted on by the Historic Preservation Commission, and review whether or not the Commission followed proper procedures, but it cannot hear or consider new evidence or testimony not already contained in the record.
